QUARTERLY SUMMARY

2nd QUARTER 2022

April 1--June 30

Crime Summary:

In the second quarter of 2022, there was a **9.6%** increase in overall crime compared to the first quarter of 2022. The top increases were in vehicle burglaries, vehicle thefts, general larceny, and vandalism. This quarter response times to emergency calls for service was 3:50 minutes, and there were a total of 8,773 incidents handled by police personnel.

Patrol Division

- Officers conducted a traffic stop in the 800 block of Washington St. and arrested several people for Grand Theft. Stolen items from Hermosa Beach and Manhattan Beach were located in the vehicle.
- Officers arrested three subjects for Grand Theft for stealing catalytic converters in the area of Maple Ave. and Center St.
- Officers arrested a subject for a robbery that occurred in the 2300 block of Rosecrans Ave.
- Officers arrested a subject for Arson in the 800 block of PCH. The subject started 3 separate fires in the area.
- The Patrol Division is conducting a Tactical Action Plan for the months of June and July. Additional officers will be deployed in the residential area on specific dates and times to combat crime.

Community Engagement Division

- Two Neighborhood Watch meetings were held this quarter. Both had great attendance numbers.
- A Coffee with a Cop Event was held at Plaza El Segundo.
- Our Crime Prevention Analyst attended the Farmers Market and the Hometown Fair to promote Neighborhood Watch.
- A School Resource Officer attended a meet-and-greet event at a co-op nursery.

Special Operations Division

- Directed Enforcement regarding stop sign violations was conducted on Main Street, which led to over 80 citations.

- Top Golf held its Grand Opening. The Special Operations Division implemented weekend details to provide police presence and assist with law violations.
- A PTA Fun Run was held in the city. Personnel from Special Operations was responsible for traffic control and participant safety.
- Special Operations participated in a Distracted Driver Awareness campaign, resulting in 314 citations.
